



## **Chairman's Report to ISORA AGM. 8th November 2025**

2025 continued to be a challenging year for ISORA and offshore racing generally. ISORA organised 16 races this season – 7 Offshores, 4 Irish Coastal race and 5 UK Coastal races. 36 boats took part in the series. Although entry numbers were reasonable, the number of boats competing in the races was disappointing. It was encouraging that the D2D race was well supported.

As a consequence of a recent accident report, the races in 2025 were run under a new ISORA safety governance regime. This requires that a “Race Risk Assessment” is prepared and submitted to an Irish Sailing or RYA registered Race Officer. It is then the decision of the Race Officer to approve, cancel or amend the details of the race. Their decision is final. This regime was adopted very successfully and operated without any significant hitches. I would like to thank **Barry MacNeaney and Larry Power** who helped to formulate a workable protocol and who also acted as Race Officers and Race Starters for most races this season. Without their cooperation, we could not have organised our races in 2025.

A huge thank you to our title sponsor for this season, **Musto**. I also want to thank our long standing sponsors on the Irish side, **Viking Marine, Hendrick Ryan Associates** and **Jack Ryan Whiskey**; and on the Welsh side, **Plas Heli** and **Tudor Auctioneers**.

Recently a **WhatsApp Discussion** group was created where significant items were raised and discussed. The summary of the discussion was issued. Some of the findings from that summary will be the basis of the agenda for this meeting. It is hoped that we can arrive at a Race Schedule and Format that will attract an increased number of boats to take part in ISORA in 2026.

With reduced entries being received this year and most of our costs being fixed, we now have to rely on our sponsors to help us fund our racing. This season was the first season where the money received on entries and sponsorship did not match our expenses. This is obviously not sustainable. I would, however, like to strongly appeal for new sponsors or benefactors for 2026.
